#### 4.2.6 Withdrawal of an approval

##### Classes 1 and 1.5

The approval shall be withdrawn as soon as four non-metallic colours are banned. In applying this rule, suspended colours will not be considered.

##### Class 2

The approval shall be withdrawn as soon as one of the following conditions is met:

- two RAL families are banned; or
- four solid, i.e. non-metallic, colours belonging to at least two different RAL families are banned.

##### Class 3

The approval shall be withdrawn as soon as three non-metallic colours are banned.

For all classes: as soon as an approval is cancelled, the supplier shall stop using any reference to the approval when selling the coating material concerned.
